You are receiving this email because you've expressed interest in the **Sanctuary Neighborhood Watch Program.**

We had our first meeting last night and began the process of forming a committee as well as designating Street Captains for each street or area throughout the neighborhood.

We are in need of MORE STREET CAPTAINS to make this program a success and truly make our neighborhood more secure.

Basic requirements of a Street Captain include:

Collect and circulate information about your neighbors – so more people know each other and can contact each other when they see something suspicious.

To the extent possible, set up a street patrol schedule – i.e. who keeps an eye on the street and when.

Act as a liaison between your neighbors and the Watch Committee
Relay and distribute Watch related information to your neighbors – such as crime incidences and what to watch for – and how to best protect your home and family.

This is not a huge time commitment, but rather a commitment to making your neighborhood a safer place to live for you and your family.

Don't think this is for someone else to do...**BE PROACTIVE.**
We don't want another family to suffer the loss and trauma that comes with being a crime victim.

Please respond to this email if you're willing to be a STREEET CAPTAIN, identify your address and the boundaries of the area you

are willing to cover.

Then stop by the Club House, pick up a form, and start collecting contact information about your neighbors, and watch your email for upcoming meetings and details.
